### VISA Processing & Requirements - Maldives

The Maldives offers one of the most traveler-friendly visa policies in the region.

For Nepali passport holders, a Visa on Arrival is granted free of charge, making travel to the Maldives simple and convenient.

## Visa Type

- Tourist Visa on Arrival (Up to 30 days)

## Requirements on Arrival

- Passport valid for at least 6 months
- Confirmed return flight ticket
- Resort or hotel booking confirmation
- Sufficient funds for the duration of stay
- Completed arrival and health declaration (as required)

- Documentation preparation guidance
- Resort and transfer confirmations arranged in advance

Important Note:

Visa extension, if required, is subject to Maldivian immigration rules. Entry is granted at the discretion of immigration officers upon arrival.

The Maldives is a year-round destination. November to April is considered the best season for calm seas and clear skies.

## Currencies accepted in Maldives

The local currency is Maldivian Rufiyaa (MVR). US Dollars are widely accepted at resorts.
